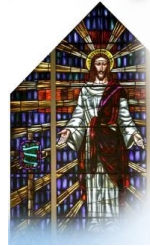

BECOME CONTAGIOUS

Fact: authentic Christian faith is contagious and God wants us to become contagious. Sounds easy, but how do we accomplish our goal? If we formed a committee of 10, more than likely we would have 10 different ideas. For the most part it is not programming, personality or preaching that attracts people. Christian congregations must first have the right priority. If the goal is to fill a worship space then we need a state of the art facility and entertainment that is over the top. However, the real question that sets our priority is do we want to fill pews or do we want to attract people to Christ? Attracting warm bodies through the door and getting names on a church roll shouldn’t be our intent. Hopefully we understand high on our list of concerns is to provide an environment where God’s love abounds and disciples are provided a place to grow stronger in faith. Bill Hybels says: “God wants us to become contagious believers...who will first catch His love and then urgently and infectiously offer it to all who are willing to consider it. This is His primary plan; the one Jesus modeled so powerfully; to spread God’s grace and truth person to person until there is an epidemic of changed lives around the world.” Our understanding should be that we share what we know personally about the influence of Christ in our lives so that others will desire it

People who make a mark on the world are those in whom Christ lives and is evident in their actions and thoughts. A need, more than ever, is not more Christian institutions but rather, more Christians. Shadows and doubts can be rightfully leveled at institutions, but there is no convincing argument against a person who through the power of the Holy Spirit, God has made more Christ like. If Christ lives in us, controls our personalities the result is others will see and seek that style of life. The old adage that states we can lead a horse to water but we can’t make him drink is very correct. Christian faith is personal and a choice that must be made from experiencing Christ’s love first hand. Our opportunity is to share the living water and its effects on our lives and not coerce others into our style of faith rather it is to make them thirsty. Our lives need to be so filled with Christ that we create a thirst in others. Few would ever accept something sight unseen and the same is true in touching people with Christ. Our message will be much better understood if we show others a clear picture of what being a disciple really means. Our personal challenge is to honestly answer does our witness cause others to want to serve Christ? Are we contagious?
